

Competition Terms and Conditions

General Terms and conditions (These apply to all competitions)

- 1) All entrants must supply their own models for each competition.
- 2) All models and artists need to be at the competition registration desk either on or before their allocated times to collect their model badges and mark their attendance.
- 3) All competitions will start and finish at the exact times specified. NO EXCEPTIONS. This means if you are late then you will have less time to complete your work.
- 4) Entrants and models must remain until the end of the prize presentations.
- 5) Models must arrive with no makeup applied prior to the competition. If models arrive with makeup on they will be required to remove it.
- 6) Model may arrive with hair “prepped only” this includes hot roller setting, wig wrap, pin curl sets and the like. However if hair is “styled” in the final look points will be deducted from their final score.
- 7) All work may be photographed, recorded and published by The Show Corporation, which has the right to use images and information for future advertising, promotional purposes and sale.
- 8) To enter all competitions complete the online form and submit your entry fee- this will also cover your admission into The Show for both days.
- 9) Entrants can enter several competitions however they will still need to pay an entry fee per competition.
- 10) Entry fees are non refundable and non transferable
- 11) You agree to the use of your submission entries being used in any promotional material or online content to promote the event.
- 12) All artists are responsible for bringing all their own makeup, tools and equipment to complete their looks.
- 13) The Show management is not responsible for supplying products and/or equipment/tools.
- 14) The Show management will supply a powered workstation for each contestant, featuring a table, a standard directors chair for models, and a mirror with lights, if contestants require additional equipment they will have to bring it themselves.
- 15) Artists and models are all responsible for their own personal belongings, equipment, tools and products. The show will not be responsible for any damage or loss to personal effects.
- 16) A panel of judges will judge each category (except the Showcase event which is peer voted by The Show attendees on the day.) All decisions are final and cannot be contested.
- 17) All competitors must display strict hygiene standards in the application of makeup and hair and are responsible for cleaning their workstation afterwards leaving the area how they found it.
- 18) To assist fellow competitors noise and conversation levels are to be kept to a minimum and no smoking, drinking, eating will be permitted in the competition area.
- 19) Failure to comply with competition rules and guidelines may result in disqualification at The Show management’s discretion.

Rules specific to each competition

Showcase event Rules and guidelines

- 1) Models for this competition can be either male or female.
- 2) Entrants role is to assist your professional artist with the make up / hair application.
- 3) Entrants will supply and be responsible for costuming their model.
- 4) Costuming may be done in advance
- 5) The Show Sydney will supply all prosthetic appliances.
- 6) You are not required to use all the prosthetics in your selection however you must apply at least three appliances.
- 7) Outside appliances will not be permitted for use – with the exception of bald caps and or lace hair pieces/ hair laying
- 8) Hair may be prepped in advance (prior to the event.) This includes hair wrapping for wigs or bald caps
- 9) Competitors will have 3 hours to compete their design including any hair, makeup, & costuming requirements. NO EXCEPTIONS

Fantasy event Rules and guidelines

- 1) Models for this Competition must be female.
- 2) No assistants will be permitted. The competitor must apply all hair and makeup by him/herself
- 3) Entrants will supply and be responsible for costuming their model.
- 4) Costuming may be done in advance
- 5) Provided all WH&S guidelines are met, and the safety of your model is not compromised outside appliances will be permitted for use In this competition items such as, False nails, Prosthetics, Wigs, False teeth, Diamantes, bald caps Horns, Lashes, Contact lenses, flowers etc... are all acceptable, if you are unsure if your additional material will be accepted please contact The Show management

- 6) Any glitter used must be cosmetics grade glitter.
- 7) Competitors will have 4 hours to compete their design including any hair, makeup, & costuming requirements. NO EXCEPTIONS

Body Painting competition.

- 1) Models for this competition may be male or female
- 2) No assistants will be permitted. The competitor must apply all hair and makeup by him/herself
- 3) At least 80% of the body must be painted.
- 4) Wigs, hair pieces, and hats are acceptable and hair can be prepped prior to the event to cater to this.
- 5) All body paints, glues, glitters and any products used must be deemed as safe to be applied to the face and body and must be cosmetics grade complying with standard OH&S practices.
- 6) Stencils, Sponges, Paintbrushes and airbrushing may be used in this event.
- 7) Contact lenses can be used and may be applied prior to the event.
- 8) Nudity is not allowed As a minimum your model will be required to wear a G-string. Nipple covers may also be used.
- 9) Competitors are required to supply a drop sheet if they are creating with any products that may spill onto the floor.
- 10) The competition area will be available from 9am for set up
- 11) Competitors will have 6 hours to compete their design including any hair, makeup, & costuming requirements. NO EXCEPTIONS
